As a multi-year awardee of the SBA's Federal and State Technology (FAST) program since 2011, the SBDC has worked in concert with SUNY, the SUNY Research Foundation, and partnering higher educational institutions (CUNY, PACE and Columbia) to expose our clients to the funding opportunities offered by the eleven largest federal agencies via the Small Business Innovation Research and Technology Transfer grants (SBIR/STTR). The FAST program seeks to improve the participation of small technology firms in the innovation and commercialization of new technology by partnering with non-profit research institutions. With funding from SBA, our educational host institutions and New York State, SBDC technology advisors effectively help researchers, scientists and business owners actualize the potential of their innovative ideas.
